Bible and Book Studies

The Weekly Bible Study with The Reverend Ed –Father Ed will be on vacation on Sunday, August 31st, therefore, Bible Study will not be held. On Sunday, September 7th we will study Luke 15:1-10, lost sheep, lost coin.

The Tuesday Morning Book Study will resume on September 9th. We will be studying The First Paul: Reclaiming the Radical Visionary Behind the Church's Conservative Icon by Marcus Borg and John Dominic Crossan. "Borg and Crossan reveal a figure who, besides being neither anti-Semitic, anti-sex, nor misogynist, stresses social and political equality among Christians and between them and others. A refreshing and heartening exculpation of a still routinely maligned figure of the first importance to culture and civilization." — Booklist (starred review) John Dominic Crossan and Marcus J. Borg—two of the world's top-selling Christian scholars and the bestselling authors —once again shake up the status quo by arguing that the message of the apostle Paul, considered by many to be the second most important figure in Christianity, has been domesticated by the church. Christian Education at St. Paul's: We believe in making "God is Everywhere" real for our young people and helping them see the many ways Christians share the Fruit of the Spirit through Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness, and Self-Control.
