### **A note from Miss Flowers**

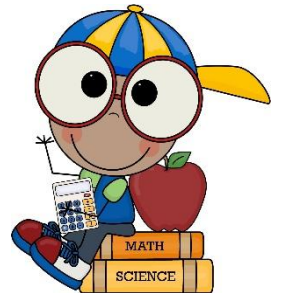
#### **Hello, St. Paul's Parishioners,**
