This Sunday, St Paul's welcomes The Rev Sister Carol Andrew, OSH. She entered the Order of St. Helena in 1972, took her Life Vow in 1978, and was ordained to the priesthood in 1994. Besides taking part in everything that keeps them operating well, her ministries have largely been spiritual direction, supply work, and conducting quiet days and retreats, mostly in the US. She grew up in New York State but has adopted the south as her home. She was stationed in Augusta GA three times before she came down in 1995 to stay. After much search all over the US and Canada we decided to remain in this area, so in 2015 we moved into the convent they built in N Augusta.

She is a musician (piano), an angler, and an animal lover. Other things she has moved in and out of, like knitting, Greek and Hebrew, needlepoint, crocheting, etc. You may know that there are very few clergy called to do supply work. Mostly they do it when they are in between calls or have retired. But in her case, it really is her primary call as a priest.

So she is very glad to be with you this Sunday.

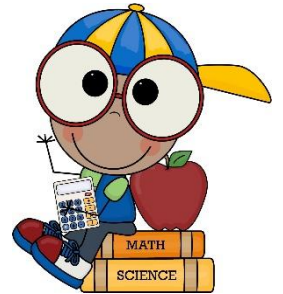
Nursery and Kid's Corner begin at 9:45 AM for the month of July, both located in Homan Hall.
