5. 8 or 12 oz heavy duty coated bowls

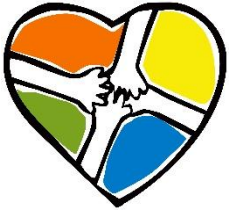
The occasional case of 8 oz water bottles would also be wonderful (very important to only purchase 8 oz water bottles, because this works best for the children).
