Bíble Study

The Weekly Bible Study with The Reverend Ed: This Sunday April 20th, we will discuss John 20:19-31, doubting Thomas. Next Sunday, April 27th, we will discuss John 21:1-19, The Restoration of Peter.

Book Study will meet on April 22nd at 11AM in Kid's Corner. We will discuss "Holy Week" and finish our study of the book "Wondrous Encounters" by Richard Rohr.

We will take a break on Tuesday, April 29. Then we will meet all four Tuesdays in May - 6, 13, 20, 27 - before breaking for the Summer. We will return Tuesday, September 9.

Our book for May will be **"Prayer in the Night: For Those Who Work or Watch or Weep" by Trish Harrison Warren.** The author is an Anglican priest. She grew up in Southern Baptist churches and is a graduate of Wake Forest and Gordon Conwell Theological Seminary. She is an Opinion writer for The New York Times and her book "Prayer in the Night" won Christian Book of the Year in 2022.

Support Defend the Fatherless/National Foster Care Month

Greetings parishioners!

May is National Foster Care Month. The Missions & Outreach Committee is partnering with our parishioner Janice Hage to collect **new** clothing for foster children for the 'clothing closet' at Defend the Fatherless, a 501(c)(3) charity based in York County, SC. While they are located in York County, they serve families in Lancaster, Chester and even some come from Columbia! Some children arrive at their new foster homes with very little, some with nothing. Their new foster families can shop the York County Foster Closet *at no cost to them* for much needed items for the child. Children 24 months on up to youth size 16 (boys/girls) and teens (adult mens/ladies) sizes are needed; ladies junior sizes would also be welcome.

The specific items and sizes we are requesting are shown below:

New pajamas, spring, summer and fall styles

24 months, 2T-5T, child size 6-16 Adult S, M, L, XL and some XXL would be welcome

New socks, any style welcome, especially no-show and ankle styles

Children, youth and adult sizes

New underwear

Bikini, hipster and brief styles for girls and ladies; boxers, briefs and boxer briefs for boys and men Children, youth and adult sizes
