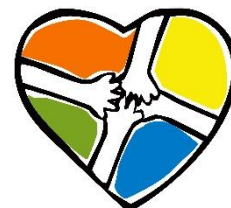


Easter Egg Fillers Are Needed by 10:00 AM Saturday, April 19th.
